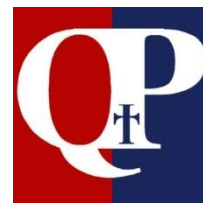


Messy Play Day

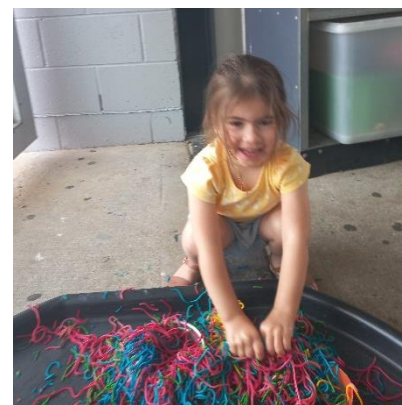
Sensory play is an important part of the play and learning that we do at OLQP Occasional Care and Playgroup.
